Traveling can be an adventure when you have good companions. But even among the best of companions disagreement may happen. Disagreements need to be handled quickly or bigger problems may arise (Pr 17:14). Paul and Barnabas had been through a lot together...good and bad. But in Acts 15 they have a disagreement that potentially could have been devastating. But God used it his glory and the witness of the gospel continued. Let's look at Paul's companions and see how to be better witnesses for Jesus (Ac 15:36-16:5).
