SERMON NOTES:

The ACTS of US: 28- "NO!"

Text: Acts 16:5-15; Various

Date: 08-02-2020 Beaver Creek Christian Church

No one likes being told "NO!" It hurts. Sometimes we pout, cry, throw tantrums, ask "why," and sometimes we even do it anyway. In Acts 16:6-15, God tells Paul and his companions "NO!" Sometimes God says "NO!" to our plans. We must learn to take divine rejection and guidance in our lives and in our ministry of service to him. Let's look at God's rejection of Paul's plans and see what we can learn about facing divine rejection of our plans.

1. The Forbidden Path- When God says, "NO!" (Ac 16:6,7; Mt 9:36-38; Re 3:7) -

2. A Open Door -When God says, "GO!" (Ac 16:9,10; Ps 51:17)-

3. The Open Heart - When God says, "YES!" (Ac 16:14-15; Ez 1:1, 3:15; Da 10:4; Re 2:18-29)-

God's way and timing are always best. We should never look at God saying "NO!" as a rejection of us personally. So when God says "NO!" look for the open door he provides! When God says "GO!" get moving with the right heart! When God says "YES!" be ready to do what he ask of you! Humble yourself and follow God's leading (Ro 12:3).
