Text: Acts 16:16-40; Various

Date: 08-09-2020 Beaver Creek Christian Church

There is something powerful about music and song. Music and song is a great way to worship and praise God. Music and praise go together in the Bible (Ps 95:1; Ep 5:18-20; He 2:12; Ps 22:22). The easiest and shortest way to get to the heart of God and get victory over any situation and circumstance, no matter how big, is through acceptable praise. It is a guarantee for victory and a mighty tool in the hand of every believer. Paul and Silas teach us a good lesson in handling bad situations and circumstances with praise and prayer. Just Sing!

1. Just Sing When Evil People Are Shadowing You! (vs 16-18)
2. Just Sing When You Suffer For Your Faith! (vs 19-23; 1 Th 5:16-18; Mt 5:11-12)
3. Just Sing In The Darkness of Night! (vs 24-29; Ps 16:7-9)

Just Sing When The Victory Is Won! (vs 30-40). There are many praises in the conclusion of this story including the salvation of the jailer and his whole household. So no matter what your situation or circumstances are this morning you can have peace in Jesus Christ. He will give you a reason to praise God. "JUST SING!"
