The ACTS of US: 30- Eager To Preach, Eager To Hear

Text: Acts 17:1-15; Various

Date: 08-16-2020 Beaver Creek Christian Church

There are people trying to turn the world upside-down through politics, protest, violence, and destruction. But Paul and Silas were actually accused of turning the world upside-down (Ac 17:6). They did this through proclaiming Christ, reasoning, and persuading people that Jesus is the promised Messiah (Acts 17:1-15). I believe that like Paul, we need to be eager to proclaim, explain, and persuade for the time is short. And our audience needs to be like the noble Bereans and be eager to listen.

1. The Bereans were not enslaved to their own prejudices. Paul shared the gospel message with them and they listened! (1 Co 11:14; 1 Sa 25:22; De 6:3-5; Mt 11:13; 13:9, 43; Mk 4:9,23; 7:16; Lk 8:8, 14:35; Re 2-3)
2. The Bereans did not blindly accept the apostle's assertions. Paul reasoned and explained that Jesus was the Messiah according to the scriptures. (Is 1:18)
3. The Bereans eagerly accepted the message after careful study. Paul allowed the Holy Spirit to work in the hearts and minds of people to bring them to their own conclusion.

Let's Be Eager to Preach! Every Christian is a preacher. You need to be prepared to proclaim Christ, explain the Scriptures, and demonstrate Christ alive in you. Let us be eager, willing and ready to share the good news because the time is short (1 Tm 4:2).
