

THE LOADED QUESTION

Lawyers can asked loaded questions.

- ❖ The question for Jesus was a landmine (Luke 10:24-29).
- This lawyer was "testing" Jesus ekpeirazó (ek-pi-rad'-zo) indicates an extreme and unwarranted: badgering the witness.
- Gader means fence or wall in Hebrew the circle around a command to keep one from accidentally breaking it.
- What the Lawyer wanted to know: "How far does my responsibility go?
- ❖ Jesus was about to draw a broader gader or circle than anyone could imagine.

- The title of priest brought prestige, power, and accolades. VIP mentality.
- Sometimes that happens to us when we have a title...especially in the church... preacher, elder, deacon, team leader, etc.
- As Church Leaders we should lead like Jesus (Jn 8:50; Ph 2:5-11; Mk 9:35; Jn 13:12-17) submission, humility, serving, setting the example.
