Big Idea: The church is to work together in ministry to equip every member for the work, build up the body of believers, to obtain unity in knowledge, and to reach our full potential in Christ.

VISIONEERING refers to the engineering of vision. Visioneering is is “a clear mental picture of what could be, fueled by the conviction that it should be.” Long before someone imagined the idea of Visioneering, The Apostle Paul was challenging the members of the church to work together toward full potential of what the church should be (Ep 4:1-16). Let’s take a look at what this involves:

1. Visioneering recognizes every member is equipped for ministry! (Ep 4:12a; 2 Tm 3:16-17; Ro 13:6-8)

2. Visioneering is body building exercise for the church! (Ep 4:12b; Ep 2:10; Mt 5:16; 1 Pe 4:10-11; Ac 2:42-47)

3. Visioneering is obtaining unity of the knowledge of Christ! (Ep 4:13-14)

How do we become visioneers?
